III. Officers Report

- a. Presidents Report
 - 1. Neighborhood made a total of \$10,100 this year in interest, compared to \$1,500 last year.
 - 2. The garage sale and craft fair will be held this weekend.
 - 3. Preserve Maintenance
 - 1. Two proposals this far and another company will be coming out tomorrow. We hired an environmentalist from Turrell Hall & Associates to create a preserve maintenance plan to make sure we are compliant with the county's rules and regulations. Frequency for treatments will be at least 3-4 times for the first two years, and potentially 1 treatment per year for the following two years, with the goal to have no need for treatments after that.

IV. Management Report

- a. Financials
 - 1. We are currently in a good financial position and are finalizing the financial review.
 - 2. From a delinquency standpoint we are in a good position with only three owners currently delinquent.
- b. Hurricane Milton
 - 1. We didn't budget for the extra storm cleanup of about \$1K. Six palm trees that were damaged along Sherbrook Drive will be removed and not replaced, but will be sodded over.
 - 2. The pool furniture was stored, and the pool pumps were shut off prior to the storm. Pool is now open.
- c. Annual Meeting

1. Notice has gone out and the annual meeting will be held on Thursday, December 12th, 2024.

V. Old Business

- a. Pool House Project Update
 - 1. The county required us to have architectural drawings prepared. The drawings were sealed and submitted within a week. We expect to get the men's bathroom completed in November.
 - 2. The women's bathroom is currently operational.

VI. Homeowner Questions and Comments

- a. One homeowner wanted to know when the villas would be painted.
 - 1. That will be answered at the Villas board meeting next week.
- b. One homeowner asked what to do about some of the blacktop on Stanhope Circle because there are areas where it looks bad.
 - 1. Robin said she can call the county, and they will come look at it and make repairs if necessary.
